



Welcome to Artsy Dori™ - an Artsy Traveler's Notebook Workshop

The supplies listed are suggested supplies for class. Not all supplies are required. It is recommended you watch the lessons before you purchase supplies. Then shop your stash and try to use things you have on hand. You can also substitute items. If you need to shop, a lot of the items can be found at your local craft store. An online supply list can be found in the classroom.

Any measurements listed are to create an Artsy Dori™ traveler's notebook cover that holds notebooks that are 5" x 8 ¼".

- Canvas or duck cloth fabric - ½ yard (recommended fabric)
- (Substitution fabric) heavier weight cotton or muslin
- Coordinating fabric for inside cover - at least 9" x 12"
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Paint brushes
- Palette knife or key card
- Paint palette or deli paper
- Gesso -white
- Selection of acrylic paints - craft paints are fine
- Various stencils or mark making tools
- Various selection of fabric scraps to coordinate with paint
- Embellishments to coordinate (buttons, trim, beads, ribbon, etc.)
- Embroidery thread to coordinate
- Sewing or embroidery needles
- Rubber stamps - letter stamps and shapes
- Archival ink pad for stamping
- Paint markers or gel pens
- Straight pins
- Double sided fusible web (called Steam A Seam - comes in 9x12 sheets)
- Elastic cording in color of your choice - 2mm thickness recommended
- Hole punch - 1/8"
- 2 decorative buttons for spine to hold the elastic bands
- 4-6 notebooks in 5 ¼" x 8" size - Moleskine cahier recommended
- Sewing machine (optional)
- Sewing thread for machine + bobbin thread (optional)
- Fabric glue if not using a sewing machine (optional)
